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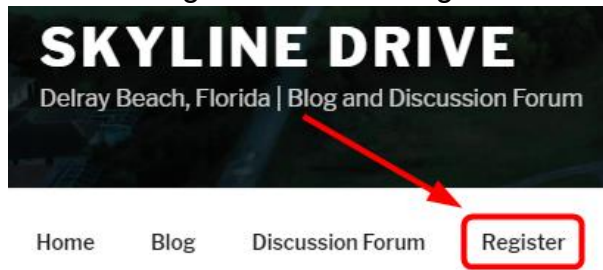
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Registering and Logging in:


A registered account on the Skyline Drive discussion forum is required to start discussions, reply to existing discussions, or follow discussions and sections to receive email notifications when a new post or reply is made.

Follow these instructions to create an account.

1. Click on "Register" on the navigation bar



2. Scroll down until you see the fields to enter a username and email

3. Enter a username in the username field. This is what you will log in as and appear as on the forum (unless you set a separate display name later on). This username can not be changed.
4. Enter your email address in the email address field. Emails are never published publicly.
5. Read the forum rules and check the boxes if you agree.
6. Click "Register"
7. Check your email for instructions and next steps to set your password. The email will appear as from "Skyline Drive Discussion Forum" and have a subject line of "Your username and password info". If you do not see the email in your inbox, check your junk email folders. If it does not show up there, retry the registration process.

8. Click the link provided in the email

2. Navigate to the forum section where you wish to read inside.

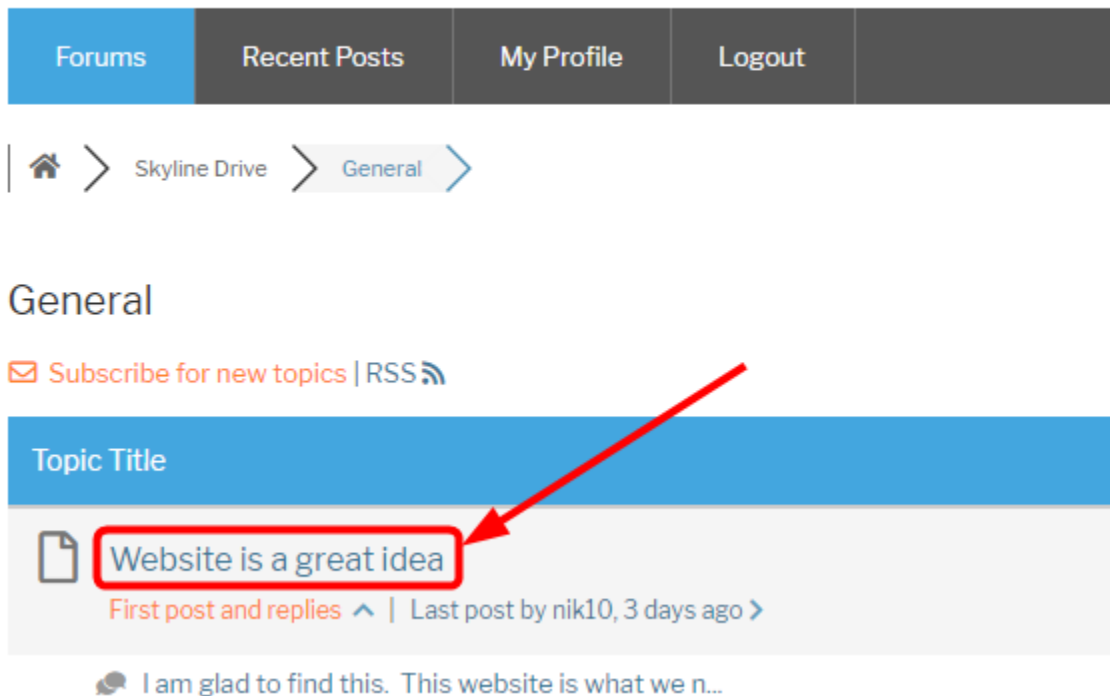


7. Click “add topic” when you are ready to post your discussion. Posts can be edited after adding. All posts and replies will be held for review by administrators before they are made public.

2. Scroll down to below the last reply.
3. Start typing in the field below the last reply

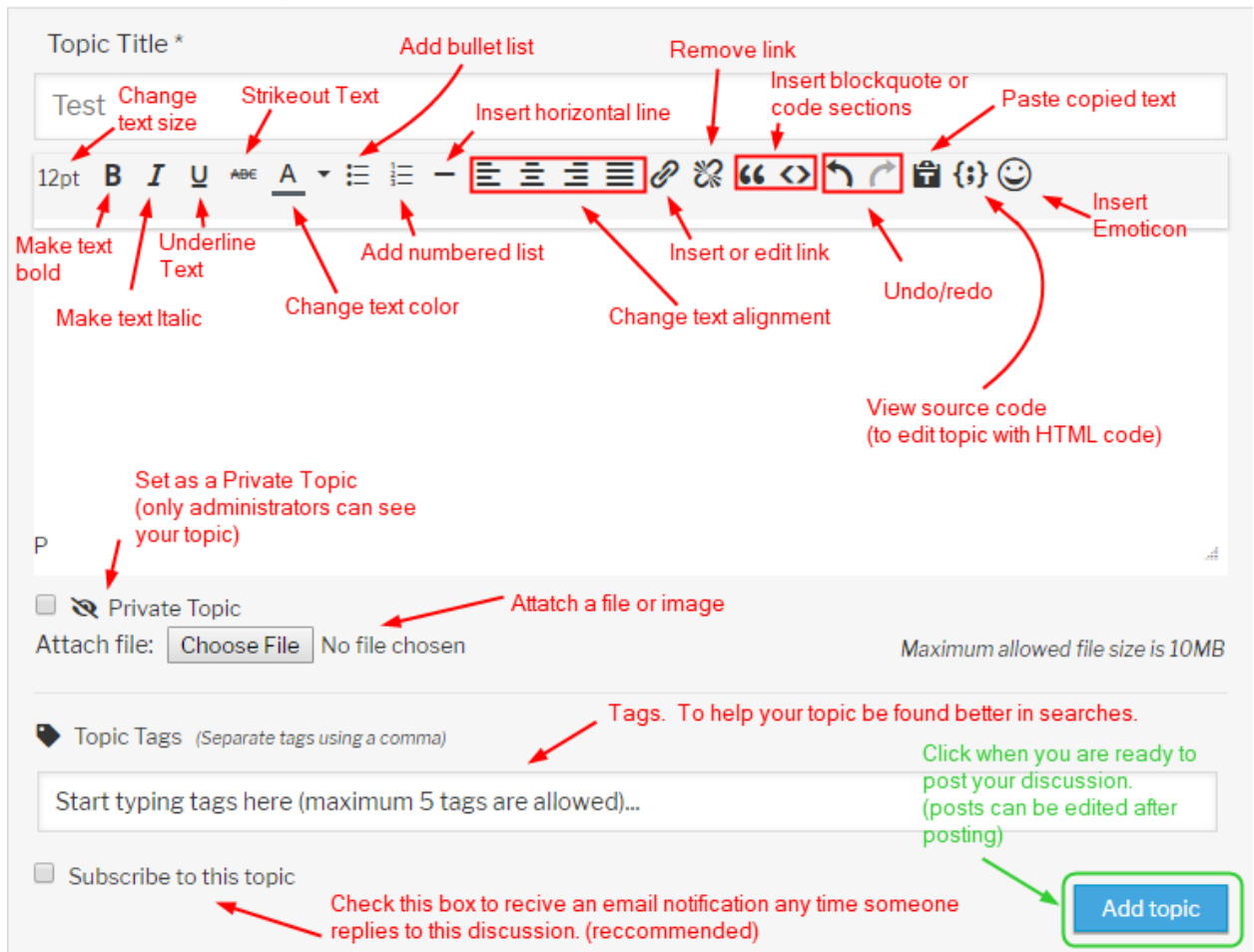

6. Click “Add Reply” when you are ready to post your reply. Any posts can be edited after posting. All posts and replies will be held for review by administrators before they are made public.

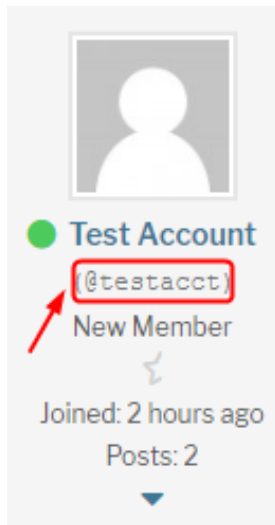
NOTE: If you check the “subscribe to this topic” box you will receive an email requiring you to confirm your subscription. You must do this in order for you to receive notifications when replies are made.

“Mentioning” Members in Posts:

“Mentioning” a member in a post is a way to notify a particular user when that post is made.

To “mention” a user, while composing or editing your post, insert an “@” symbol and then the members username. Note that this is not always the members display name.

Please refer to the smaller text below the display name of a member to get a username that you can use when mentioning.



Editing or Deleting Your Posts:

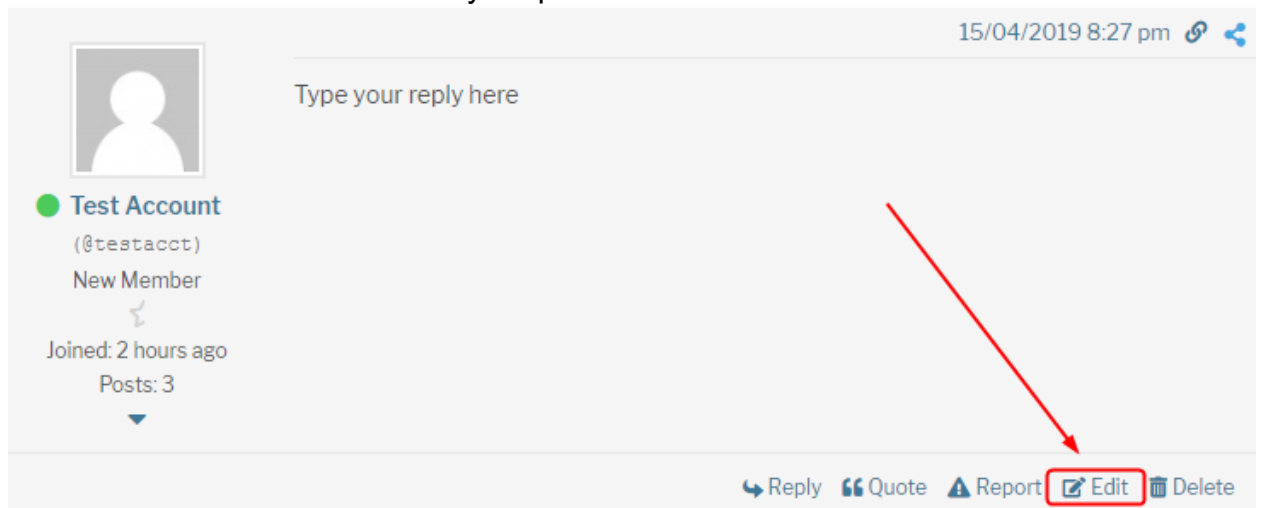
Your replies can be edited or deleted at any time.

Your topics can be edited at any time but can only be deleted within 10 minutes of posting.


Administrators can edit or delete topics or replies at any time.

To edit one of your topics or posts follow the steps below.
















1. Navigate to where you are viewing the topic or reply you wish to edit.
2. Click "Edit" on the bottom bar of your post.



3. Enter whatever edits you need to, including attaching files if needed.



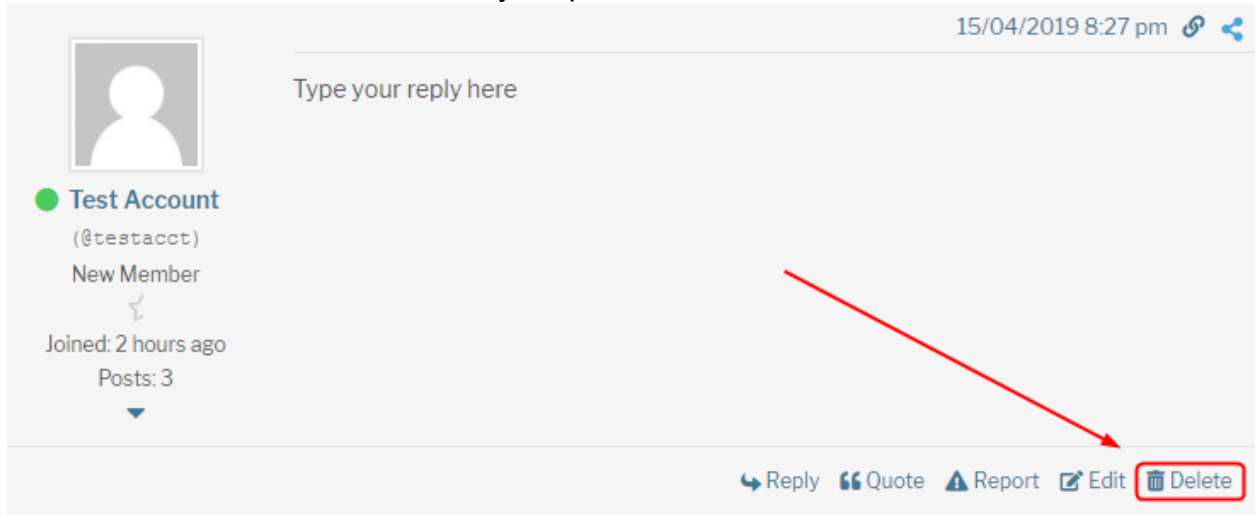
To delete one of your topics or replies, follow the steps below.

NOTE: Replies can be deleted at any time, but topics can only be deleted within 15 minutes of posting.

Administrators can edit or delete topics or replies at any time.

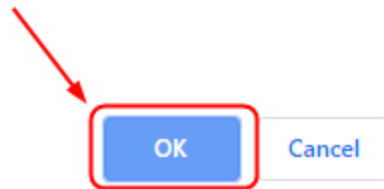
1. Navigate to where you are viewing the topic or reply you wish to delete.

2. Click “delete” on the bottom bar of your post.



3. You will be asked to confirm deletion. Click ok and your post will be deleted. This action can not be undone.

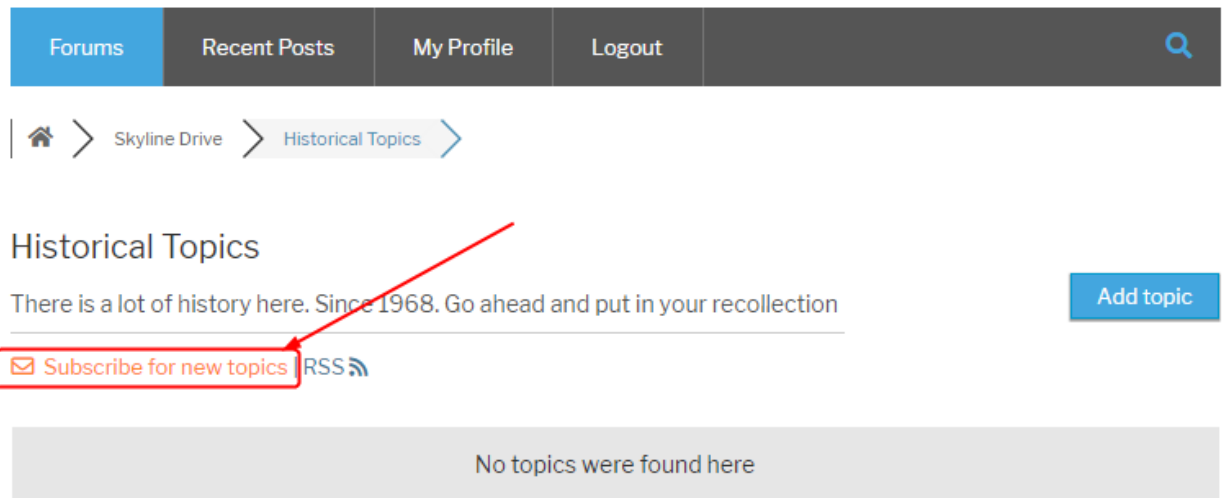
Subscribing to Forum Sections or Discussions:

You can subscribe to forum sections or discussions to get notified whenever there is a new topic created in that forum section or a reply is posted in a particular discussion.

Follow the instructions below to subscribe to a forum section:

1. Confirm you are logged into your account. Subscriptions can only be made when logged in.
2. Navigate to the forum section you wish to subscribe to.

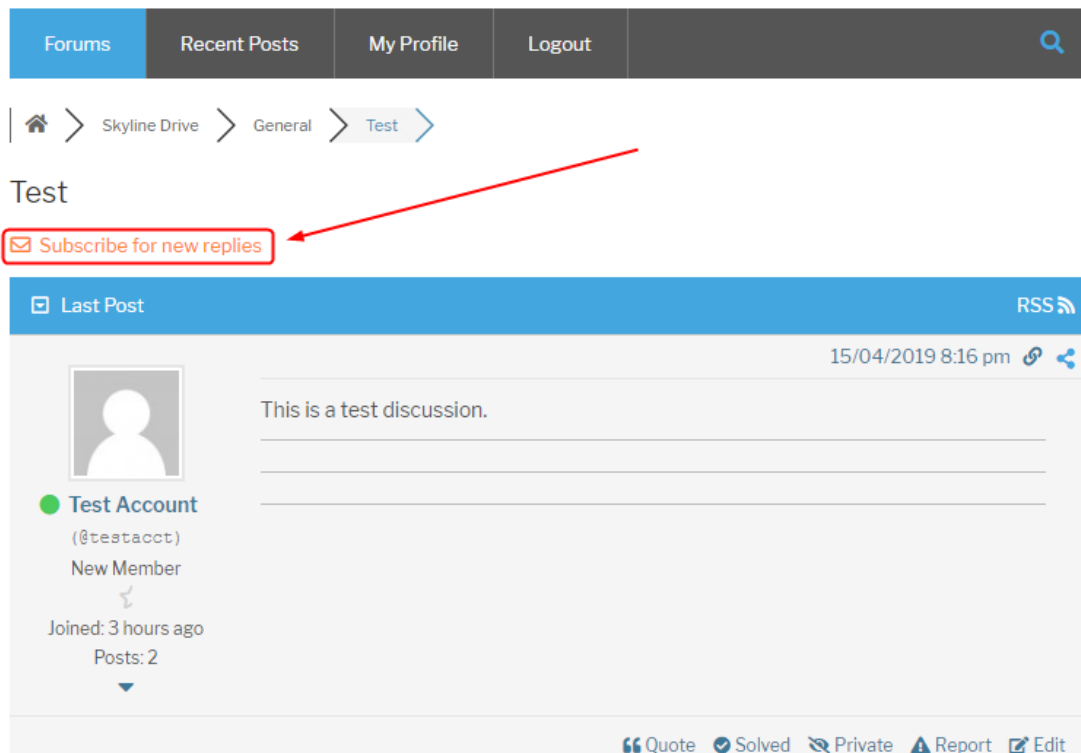
3. Click “Subscribe for new topics”
